

Ohio Disability Financial Assistance (DFA)

What is DFA?

Ohio's DFA program provides a monthly cash benefit to eligible low-income individuals with disabilities who do not meet all the requirements necessary to receive help from other federal and state programs such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Ohio Works First (OWF).

An agency representative will contact you for an interview to process your application. Certain items such as citizenship, household composition, disability information, income, resources and expenses must be verified. Normal processing requires that benefits be issued or the application be denied within 30 days.
