Title XX is a flexible federal funding source that Seneca County Department of Job and Family Services (SCDJFS) receives through the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) based on an annual allocation. This allocated money is used in the operation of social services programs. These funds are distributed by the state, but the county JFS determines what services will be available in the community.

ODJFS requires each county Job and Family Services agency to complete a plan on a biennial basis – currently for the federal fiscal years, October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022 and October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023. ODJFS also requires that a public hearing be held during a planning committee meeting.
